

**EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF MCA 5
(CAINSCROSS TOWN)
STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has by this emergency notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of public footpath MCA 5 from its junction with Public Footpath MCA 6 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 82893/04902 and then extends in a generally westerly direction for approximately 180 metres to its junction with Chapel Lane at OSGR SO 82716/04871 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

The public footpath falls in Cainscross in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;

The closure is necessary to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to the footpath being blocked by a collapsed wall.

This Notice came into force on the 22nd January 2025 and will continue for up to 21 days. However, if the works to remedy the problem have not been completed during this time scale it will be necessary to either extend the closure by Notice for a further 21 days, or make an Order. If made the Order can authorise the closure of the public footpath for up to six months from the date of this Notice.

Alternative Routes – As shown on the Order Plan by a dashed black line marked A to C to D to B.

Emergency and Pedestrian access to adjoining premises is to be maintained.
